With a mission to mentor and empower teen girls for future success through promoting academic excellence, leadership skills, community service, career preparation, and self-esteem, I founded GIRL in 2010 to prepare today's girls to be the next generation of scientists, engineers, CEOs, entrepreneurs, politicians, doctors, or whatever they desire to be and to help them realize their goals. In service to the community, GIRL has hosted 3 MLK Day of Service events in partnership with the City of Fairfax Commission for Women, and girls have also collected and donated holiday food baskets to Second Story and made Christmas cards for residents of a local nursing home.
